1. Buy a Charlie Card

at the Ticket Vending Machines in the New Bedford or Fall River terminal.



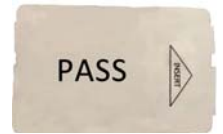
1. Fareboxes accept

\$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 dollar bills as well as \$1 coins, quarters, dimes and nickels.



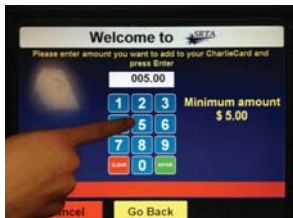
1. Buy a Pass

1-Day and Week paper passes can be purchased on the bus or at the Ticket Vending Machines. 31-Day passes can only be loaded onto a Charlie Card and purchased at the Ticket Vending Machines.



2. Load your card

at the Ticket Vending Machine using cash or online by following the MBTA link on SRTA's webpage, srtabus.com



2. Have your cash ready

when boarding the bus. Fares are \$1.50 for regular fare and \$0.75 for discounted fare.



2. Activate your paper pass

The first time you use a paper pass on the bus, insert it into the ticket slot. This will activate your pass.



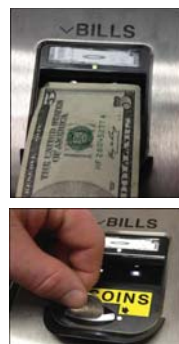
3. Board the bus

Hold your Card against the orange Charlie Card target at the lower right hand side of the farebox for at least one second.



3. Board the bus

Insert your bills in the bill slot at the lower left of the farebox. Insert your coins in the coin slot located just below the bill slot.



3. Board the bus

Each time you board a bus insert the pass into the ticket slot.
