RE: Acquisition of Maintenance Support Equipment – Forklift

Background:

The Southeastern Regional Transit Authority (SRTA) is responsible for public transit services in ten (10) communities within the Southeastern Massachusetts region, and is funded with Federal, State, and local subsidies, as well as farebox revenue. The SRTA was created pursuant to Commonwealth of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 161B, and thus is considered a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The SRTA is required to comply with the mandates of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), as are the entities with which it contracts for transit.

The resultant contract is subject to financial assistance contracts between the SRTA and the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MA DOT). As such, all Contractors must comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations.

This agreement is subject to any applicable guidelines for project administration issued by the Federal Transit Administration of the Department of Transportation of the U.S. Government and all other applicable laws, rules, and regulations. The SRTA reserves the right to reject any all proposals, or any part of any proposal that the SRTA deems it in its best interest to do so.



Scope of Work/ Specifications:

The SRTA is seeking quotes for the Acquisition or Purchase of one (1) **Maintenance Support Equipment –Forklift.** Specifications are outlined below:

Internal combustion (LPG) Sit-Down Counterbalanced 5000-pound rated Forklift
The forklift shall have side shift capability and fork positioner / 4-way Mast controls
The forklift shall have an overhead guard with a max overhead clearance with mast at rest of 85.5" or less

The forklift mast height shall not exceed 189". The forklift carriage width shall not exceed 41". The forklift shall be operated using propane fuel. The forklift shall be equipped with 42" forks

The forklift shall have the following options:

- 2 Front Headlights Attached to the Roll over protection
- The forklift shall be equipped with Power Steering
- Low Mount Audible Alarm- activated when in reverse
- Low Fuel Indicator on Dash
- Suspension style seat with seat belt
- Tilt steering wheel with horn
- Front Tires -7.00x12x14PR
- Rear Tires -6.00x9x10PR
