FY24 Draft Budget Discussion

Mr. Rousseau presented the highlights of the fiscal year 2024 draft budget. State Contract Assistance is budgeted according to the House 1 budget draft laid out by the Governor of Massachusetts and includes a nearly 9.0% increase in formula funding for the state transit authorities. Local Assessments also increased by 2.5%. The SRTA will utilize the remaining \$1.99 million of allocated CARES Funds in the upcoming year, in addition to Section 5307 Operating Assistance. Mr. Rousseau further presented some budget assumptions such as the decrease in medical insurance costs for the operator, increase in pension expense, increase in operating revenue, and decrease in fuel expense. The Pro-Forma Budgets for future fiscal years was also presented and Mr. Rousseau explained that at current funding levels, it will be difficult to maintain the SRTA's current level of service.
