FY24 Draft Budget Discussion

Mr. Rousseau gave an update on a budget change. The Information Technology expense will be moved from the Operator's budget to the Authority's budget.

(7) New Business

Fall River Service Considerations and Comment Period

Mr. Shayne Trimbell (SRTA) presented proposed route changes based off of the Fall River Service Assessment. These proposed changes include a re-alignment of the Fall River Route 1, an elimination of deviations on the Fall River Route 2, a complete elimination of the Fall River Route 6, a re-alignment and an elimination of the Battleship Cove deviation of the Fall River Route 7, an elimination of the deviations on the Fall River Route 9, and a re-alignment of the Fall River Route 10. Market demand was analyzed along with public outreach to determine these proposals.

The next public hearing will be on June 1st, 2023 at 12:00PM EST at the Fall River Terminal and the public comment period will be open from May 1st though June 1st.

Mr. Richard Brewer (Town of Westport) asked if any the proposed changes would impact the construction on route 79. Mr. Trimbell explained that there should not be any impact to route 14 which covers the area on route 79.
