(6) Old Business

FY24 Audit

Mrs. Sniezek presented the SRTA's independent auditors' report which showed that the auditors issued a clean opinion on the financial statements. There was about a \$1.7 million increase in net position for fiscal year 2024. The FY24 operating plan was presented which showed about \$600,000 of federal funding not used in FY24 which can be used in FY25. This was due to expenses being lower than anticipated in FY24. The auditors also issued a clean opinion for the SRTA's use of and accounting for federal funds.

Mr. Brewer asked what percentage the SRTA covers for medical costs for its retirees. Mrs. Sniezek responded that SRTA covers 75% of medical costs and 100% of dental costs.

Ms. Clarke asked if the SRTA's position is comparable to other regional transit authorities in Massachusetts. Mrs. Sniezek responded that it depends on the funding that is available. The SRTA has applied for and received competitive grants which has had a positive impact on the SRTA's net position. Mr. Rousseau also responded that the 40 hybrid buses that the SRTA is receiving to replace a large portion of its fleet, that is past useful life, is an example of how the competitive grants are impacting the SRTA.
